

## Ordinance Establishing Split Shifts for Election Officials

STATE OF WISCONSIN

Town of Byron

Fond du Lac County

The Town Board of the Town of Byron, Fond du Lac County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 7.30 (1) Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the selection of 2 sets of officials to work at different times on each Election Day as follows:

- A. There may be two shifts for election workers on election days. The first shift shall commence at 7:00 a.m. and end at 1:00 p.m. the second shift shall commence at 1:00 p.m. and end with completion of all required Election Day duties that follow the closure of the polls.
- B. One additional election inspector may serve as a greeter to answer questions and to direct electors to the proper locations for registration and voting and shall be available to substitute for other election officials who must leave the room during the voting process.

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
