Recycling Guidelines

Place ALL of the following in recycling cart. DO NOT BAG, except for shredded paper. Place cart at the end of your driveway by 6:00 a.m. on your scheduled recycling pick-up date. Landlords, it is your responsibility to inform your renters of these guidelines.

Material Accepted

Furniture
 Rolled carpeting (4 ft. maximum length)
 Lumber (4 ft. maximum length)
 Cabinets and/or countertops
 Mattresses/bed springs
 Non-metal doors
 Wood windows

Materials EXCLUDED

Large appliances (stoves, washers, dryers, water heaters, furnaces)
 Freon containing appliances (refrigerators, AC units, freezers)
 Tires and used oil
 Batteries
